How will we reduce stress and prevent practicing the behavior?	Exposure, Go Slow	Give reduced hiding places, such as beds with sides, to expose cat more to environment while still making them feel safe. Go slow and use calming signals when entering and interacting with cat.
How will we address the underlying cause of the behavior?	Counter Condition to Entry	Associate opening the door and entering the room with good things by entering and giving a treat multiple times throughout the day.
What alternate and desired behaviors will we teach?	No Thank You	Reinforce non-aggressive ways of asking for space by removing your hand and

		looking away when the cat looks or moves away or gives a tail flick.
What will we do if the problem behavior occurs?	Hiding	If cat hides and will not come out, leave some treats near the hidey and sit quietly for a little while to show you will not do anything scary.
Goals	From Hand	Cat will approach and eat treats from hand.
