Plan Item	Directive	Notes
How will we reduce stress and prevent practicing the behavior?	Easy Walk Harness	Walk the dog on an Easy Walk Harness.
How will we address the underlying cause of the behavior?	Counter Conditioning	Associate trigger with something the dog likes, such as treats.
What alternate and desired behaviors will we teach?	Engage/Disengage Game, Hand Targeting	Reward with treats for looking at the trigger and looking away. Teach the dog to touch their nose to your outstretched hand. Gradually move the hand further away from the dog so he/she must move to touch it.

Plan Item	Directive	Notes
Plan Item 4: What will we do if the problem behavior occurs?	Pulling on Leash	If dog pulls on leash, either stop, stand still, and wait for dog to put slack on leash or pivot in opposite direction, calling the dog to you. Give a treat as dog comes by your knee.
Goal	10 ft	Able to be within 10 ft of trigger without reacting.
